We will look at settlements, the cultures of stone age and the iron age and their legacy. We will be reading Stone Age Boy and The Wild Girl and using these to base our writing on. Our science is topic is "What's the Matter". We will be having practical fun learning about solids, liquids and gases.

English

All our English work will be based on our Tribal Tales. We will be reading different stories based on the different times periods and basing our writing on the books.

We will be focusing on character descriptions and retelling using Stone Age Boy. We will also be writing non chronological reports based on woolly mammoths and the bear in The Wild Girl.

Maths

Both year groups will be focusing on finishing multiplication and division and then moving on to Length and Perimeter. We are continuing using White Rose maths scheme with some elements of classroom secrets.

This will be supported by videos, worksheets and mini assessments throughout the different units.

Science

We will be studying "What's the Matter".

This topic is all about learning about solids, liquids, and gases. We will learn how the different elements are made up and how to classify the elements by touch and what they look like.

Homework

Children will continue to be set homework and spellings each week on a Friday, which will be due in on the following Thursday.
