We will be reading "The Great Food Bank Heist" and "Where does my food come from?" and will use these to base our writing on. Our science is topic is "Plants"

English

All our English work will be based on our topic The Journey of Food. We will be reading a couple of books to support our learning and learn more about Food Banks and how we can support this great cause.

We will be focusing on posters and nonchronological report using both of our class readers. We will also be writing a set of instructions for a recipe.

Maths

Both year groups will be focusing on fractions and then year 3 will focus on mass and capacity and year 4 will focus on decimals. We are continuing using White Rose maths scheme with some elements of classroom secrets.

This will be supported by videos, worksheets and mini assessments throughout the different units.

Science

We will be studying "Plants".

This topic is all about learning about the different parts of a flower, what things it needs to survive and how plants germinate.

Homework

Children will be set homework termly and spellings will be set each week on a Friday, which will be tested each Friday.

PE days for class 2, continue to be MONDAY and TUESDAY. The children will continue to learn team sports and individual skills.
